

Activity report

- 3 investigatory files opened during time period  
(1 against excavators, 2 against operators)
- 15 investigatory files closed during time period  
(6 prosecution declined, 5 warning letters, 3 settlements before civil action, 1 transferred to case file for civil action)
- 3 civil actions filed or still open at end of time period  
*State ex. rel. Peterson v. Antoniak Construction*, Douglas County  
*State ex. rel. Peterson v. G.P. Cable*, Lancaster County  
*State ex. rel. Peterson v. River Valley Services*, Furnas County
- 6 files placed in remediation/still in remediation (monitoring compliance with Act for a period of time pursuant to Consent Decree or Court Order)
- 1 civil case file closed after settlement or successful remediation period  
(*State ex. rel. Peterson v. River Valley Services*)
- 32 investigatory files still open and under investigation at end of time period
- Civil penalties assessed:\* \$6,500.00 (Lancaster County, Hall County, Furnas County)

\*Assessment of civil penalties and inclusion in this report is determined by the date the Consent Decree is signed by the Court, Judgment entered by the Court, or when settlement is received, if there is no Consent Decree. Amount of civil penalties includes total amount assessed, including any amount which may be waived after successful remediation period.
